CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction on the building at 150 Dunn Ave. continues and is expected to be completed by late Spring 2024.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The new four-storey building will provide homes for approximately 51 people with on-site services that can support their health and well-being. The new homes will be furnished studio apartments with a bathroom and kitchen. The building will also include amenities such as shared laundry, a commercial kitchen, a dining area, a communal area and programming space.

This project is led by the City of Toronto and the University Health Network Gattuso Centre for Social Medicine, and delivered in partnership with all orders of government, and the United Way of Greater Toronto.
