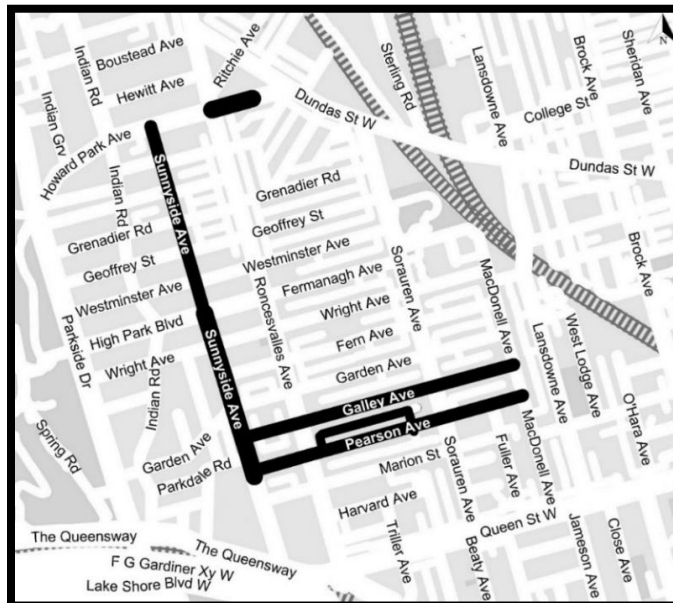

The City of Toronto will be returning to Pearson Avenue to complete water service connections and installation of catch basin/manhole on the Laneway North of Pearson Avenue & East of Roncesvalles Avenue and on Pearson Avenue. This work will start during the week of January 29, 2024, and is scheduled to be completed by the week of February 16, 2024. This work will be localized to the Laneway and its surroundings on Pearson Avenue.

Laneway reconstruction is included in the permanent restoration work as part of this project. All remaining permanent restoration work is scheduled to commence in Spring 2024, once weather conditions are favorable. Another construction update will be issued prior to work starting in the Spring.

Residents should expect construction noise in the immediate work zone. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

- Complete water service connections on the Laneway North of Pearson Avenue & East of Roncesvalles Avenue.
- Complete catch basin and manhole installation on Pearson Avenue and;
- Temporarily restore the areas impacted by the water service connections
