- 1. Madharasi Inc.** (Report No. 7884)

Applicant for an Eating Establishment Licence (Application No. C343042)

DECISION:

The Tribunal dismissed Madharasi Inc.'s application for an Eating Establishment Licence (Application No. C343042) and deemed the matter abandoned.

Municipal Licensing and Standards requested the application be deemed abandoned due to Mohamed Abdul Salavudin Sikkindar's failed attendance at the Toronto Licensing Tribunal hearings on December 14, 2023 and January 25, 2024.

- 2. Fizan Akbar** (Report No. 7791)
Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. C240658)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution signed on January 25, 2024, as follows:

"Vehicle-For-Hire-Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;

- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the Vehicle-For-Hire-Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of One (1) year. FIZAN AKBAR is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against FIZAN AKBAR and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess FIZAN AKBAR's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against FIZAN AKBAR or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7791 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
