## Watermain Replacement, Laneway Reconstruction and Sanitary Sewer Replacement on Sunnyside Avenue, Pearson Avenue, Galley Avenue and Other Local Roads

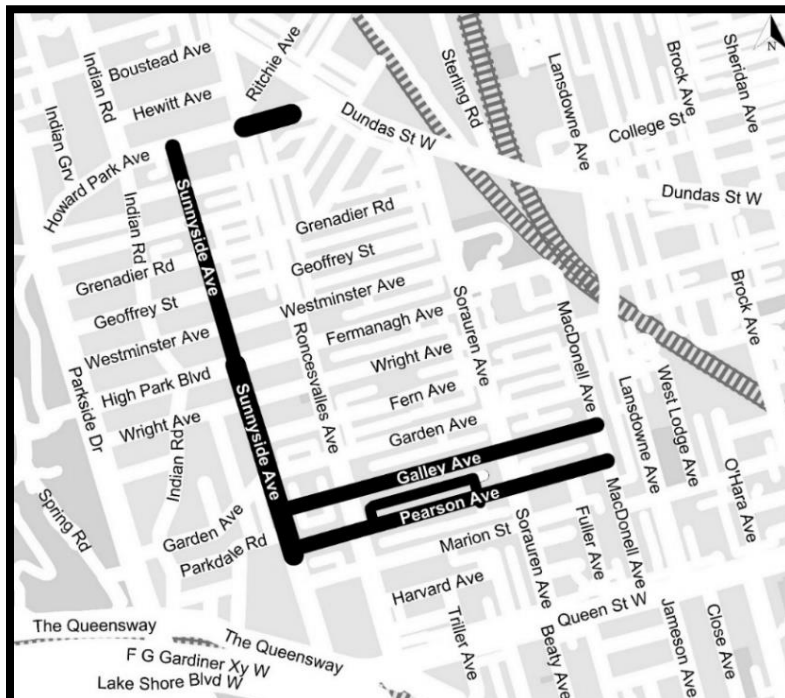
The City of Toronto’s watermain, combined sewer and service lateral pipes replacement and laneway improvement work on the below streets is almost complete. Due to ground and weather conditions, the contractor will be taking a winter break. This year’s construction work will wrap up December 18, 2023.

Prior to leaving the site, the contractor completed some concrete work for the sidewalk/curb and the roadway, temporarily restored driveways and lawn areas. Once weather conditions are favourable, the contractor will return in Spring 2024 to complete permanent restoration work. A construction update notice will be issued before work re-starts.

The contractor has:

Completed the new watermain installation on:

- Sunnyside Avenue from Pearson Avenue to Howard Park Avenue
- Pearson Avenue from Macdonell Avenue to Sunnyside Avenue
- Galley Avenue from Sunnyside Avenue to Macdonell Avenue

Completed water service connections on:

- Sunnyside Avenue from Pearson Avenue to Howard Park Avenue
- Pearson Avenue from Macdonell Avenue to Sunnyside Avenue
- Galley Avenue from Sunnyside Avenue to Roncesvalles Avenue

Completed street connections on Sunnyside Avenue and Pearson Avenue

Completed concrete trench restoration on:

- Sunnyside Avenue from Pearson Avenue to Howard Park Avenue
- Pearson Avenue from Macdonell Avenue to Sunnyside Avenue
- Galley Avenue from Sunnyside Ave to Roncesvalles Avenue

Temporarily restored areas affected by the watermain installation

Completed combined sewer and service lateral pipes replacement and permanent restoration on Howard Park Avenue

## REMAINING WORK

In spring 2024, the contractor will:

Complete water service connections and street connections on:

- Galley Avenue from Roncesvalles Avenue to Macdonell Avenue

Restoration work:

- Remove and replace concrete sidewalks and curbs impacted by construction
- Restore boulevards and driveways impacted by construction
- Resurface the portions of the road impacted by construction
- Complete permanent road base restoration
- Laneway reconstruction
