

Sanitary forcemain replacement on your street

In October 2023, the City of Toronto distributed a Construction Notice for a sanitary forcemain replacement to take place in your neighbourhood. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure, reducing the risk of forcemain breaks and collapses.

The City began preliminary activities on Morrison Street at Eleventh Street, on Morrison Street west of Second Street and at the New Toronto Sewage Pumping Station in November 2023. Due to site and technical constraints, the construction timeline has been updated to begin in July 2024 and is expected to be completed by November 2024. Restoration work, where required, will follow in spring 2025. Please see a map of the work area below.
