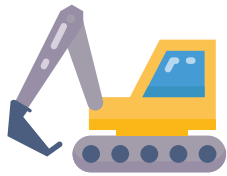


Community Benefits Framework: Creating inclusive economic development when the City buys and builds

Training and employment opportunities that reach Indigenous, Black and equity-deserving groups

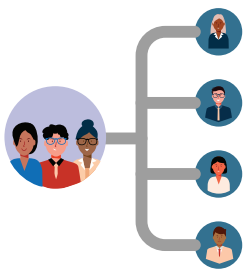


Business opportunities for local and diverse suppliers



Equitable social and economic impact through large-scale City projects, initiatives and events

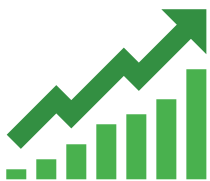
Community Benefits Framework: An innovative municipal policy and program approach



Provides coordination and guidance to City divisions, agencies, and City Councillors on community benefits initiatives

Led by the Community Benefits Unit, which also:
