

The City of Toronto allocates ice time on a priority basis according to group classifications; the Ice Allocation Policy defines this process. Prime Time ice is allocated to the following groups as follows:

- Community Youth: 60%
- Competitive Youth: 25%
- Competitive Junior Hockey: 0.5%
- Community Adult: 14%
- Commercial: 0.5%

Formula to Calculate the Weekly Time Allocation in Hours

The total time allocated to a group in a single season is calculated using the following formula (results are rounded):

$$\text{Weekly Time Allocation (hours)} = \text{Prime time ice available per week} \times \text{percentage of Ice allocated to classification type} \times [\text{League residents} \div \text{Total residents in category}]$$

For example: The total prime time ice available city-wide each week is 2,657 hours. ABC Hockey League is classified as a Community Youth Group. Community Youth are allocated 60% of prime time ice according to the Ice Allocation Policy.

ABC Hockey League has a total of 1000 participants on their roster. 920 participants are residents. The total number of residents in the Community Youth classification based on applications is 22,270. Applying the formula, the Weekly Time Allocation in Hours to ABC Hockey League would be:

$$\mathbf{66 \text{ hours}} = 2,657 \text{ hrs} \times 60\% \times [920 \text{ residents in ABC Hockey} \div 22,270 \text{ Community Youth residents}]$$

Entitlements

The following tables provide the ice allocation entitlements calculated using this formula for all 2024 - 2025 seasonal applicants.

Column Definitions

- Res: Total number of Toronto residents submitted on the roster
- Non-Res: Total number of non-residents of Toronto submitted on the roster
- Total: Total number of participants listed on the roster
- Percentage: The percentage of residents on the roster ($\text{Residents/Total Participants} \times 100\%$)
- Formula: Total entitlement of hours allocated to the group each week of the upcoming season.
