ROLLING CLOSURES ON OLD MILL DRIVE


The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. The City's Contractor Clearway Construction Inc. will be installing a Maintenance Hole in front of 37 Old Mill Drive. Due to the nature of this work, Old Mill Drive will be reduced to one lane in the vicinity of the work zone and full road closures will take place intermittently throughout the day.

The Maintenance Hole installation work is scheduled to take place Friday, March 8, 2024, to Thursday March 21, 2024, 7 a.m to 7 p.m. The road closure on Old Mill Drive near Riverside Drive will be opened prior to the commencement of the Maintence Hole installation work at 37 Old Mill Drive, as depicted in the maps below.


This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate the road and sidewalk to install a maintenance hole.
- Restoration of the sidewalks and road to complete the project.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

- During the rolling closures, one or two lanes on Old Mill Drive near 37 Old Mill Drive will be blocked.
- One lane of traffic will be provided intermittently throughout the day and flag people will be onsite to assist with the flow of traffic.
- One lane of traffic will be open at the end of the working day after 7 p.m. with yield signs in place.
- At all times access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.



Pedestrians: There will be impacts to existing sidewalk on the East side of Old Mill Drive; however, safe pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and flag people will be onsite to assist.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Accessible Accommodation: Residents / businesses that require accommodation (level entry, wheel trans entry etc.) must contact the **Field Ambassador** to arrange for access during the construction period.
