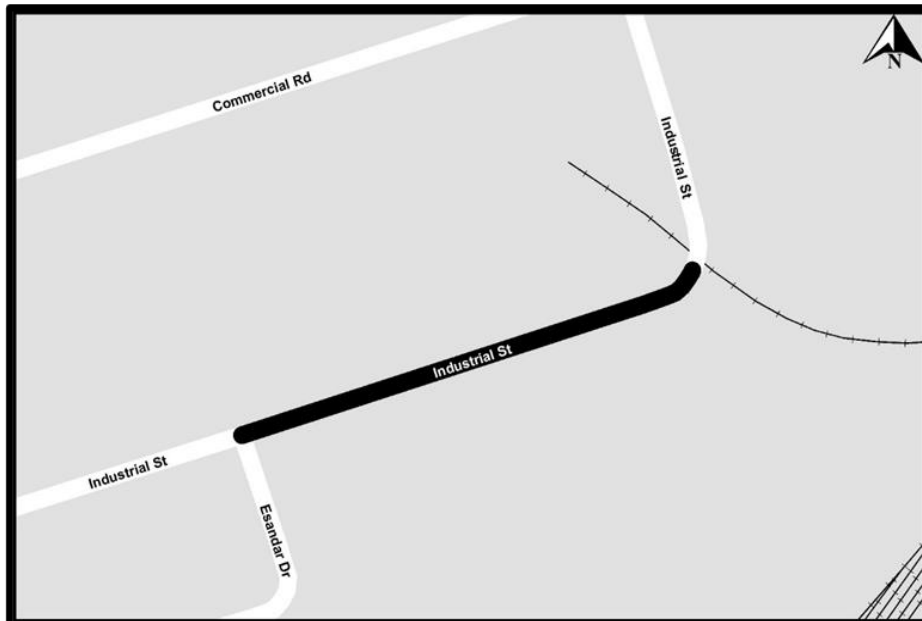
Watermain Replacement and Sanitary Sewer Replacement on Industrial Street from 38 Industrial Street to 50 Industrial Street

This notice provides an update on the sanitary sewer and watermain replacement work on Industrial Street from 38 Industrial Street to 50 Industrial Street. Work was halted over the winter months and is expected to resume on April 8, 2024 with a revised end date of July 1, 2024.
