TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ON CATHERINE STREET



Expected Start Date: Monday, April 8, 2024 Expected End Date: Friday, April 19, 2024 *Timeline is subject to change

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. As part of the work, the City's Contractor, Clearway Construction Inc., will be completing road reconstruction on Catherine Street. Due to the nature of this work, Catherine Street will be closed between Old Mill Drive and Old Mill Bridge effective 7:00 a.m. on Monday, April 8, 2024, to 5:00 p.m. Friday, April 19, 2024, as depicted in the map below.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Demobilize trailer from Catherine Street.
- Complete road reconstruction works on Catherine Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

- Catherine Street between Old Mill Drive and Old Mill bridge will be fully closed throughout the duration of the work.
- During the road closure, access to the parking lot at Etienne Brulé Park will not be accessible to vehicles.

At all times access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.



Pedestrians: Pedestrian access on the south side of Catherine Street will be maintained during construction.

The stairway east of Old Mill Bridge to access Etienne Brulé Park will remain open.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
