
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE KING HIGH AVENUE, LAURELCREST AVENUE AND FAYWOOD BOULEVARD

Contract: 21ECS-LU-04FP
Expected Start Date: March 25,2024
Expected End Date: April 17, 2024

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the sanitary sewer construction work, the work will be completed in two stages.

For Stage 1, the intersection of King High Avenue will be closed for the sanitary sewer system installation, along with full rolling closures on Laurelcrest Avenue moving west toward Faywood Boulevard effective from 7:00 a.m. on Monday, March 25, 2024. For Stage 2, the intersection of Faywood Boulevard and Laurelcrest Avenue will be closed with the full rolling road closure on the west half of Laurelcrest Avenue for the sanitary sewer system installation. The closures are scheduled to end Wednesday, April 17, 2024 at 7 p.m. This project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.


MAP OF WORK AREA - STAGE 1

WORK DETAILS

Work crews will:

 Modify and upgrade the sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

- Stage 1, the intersection of King High Avenue and east half of Laurelcrest Avenue will be closed for the sanitary sewer system installation.
- Stage 2, the intersection of Faywood Boulevard and the west half of Laurelcrest Avenue will be closed for the sanitary sewer system installation.
- Access will remain open to local traffic.

	Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.
广	Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.
1	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
