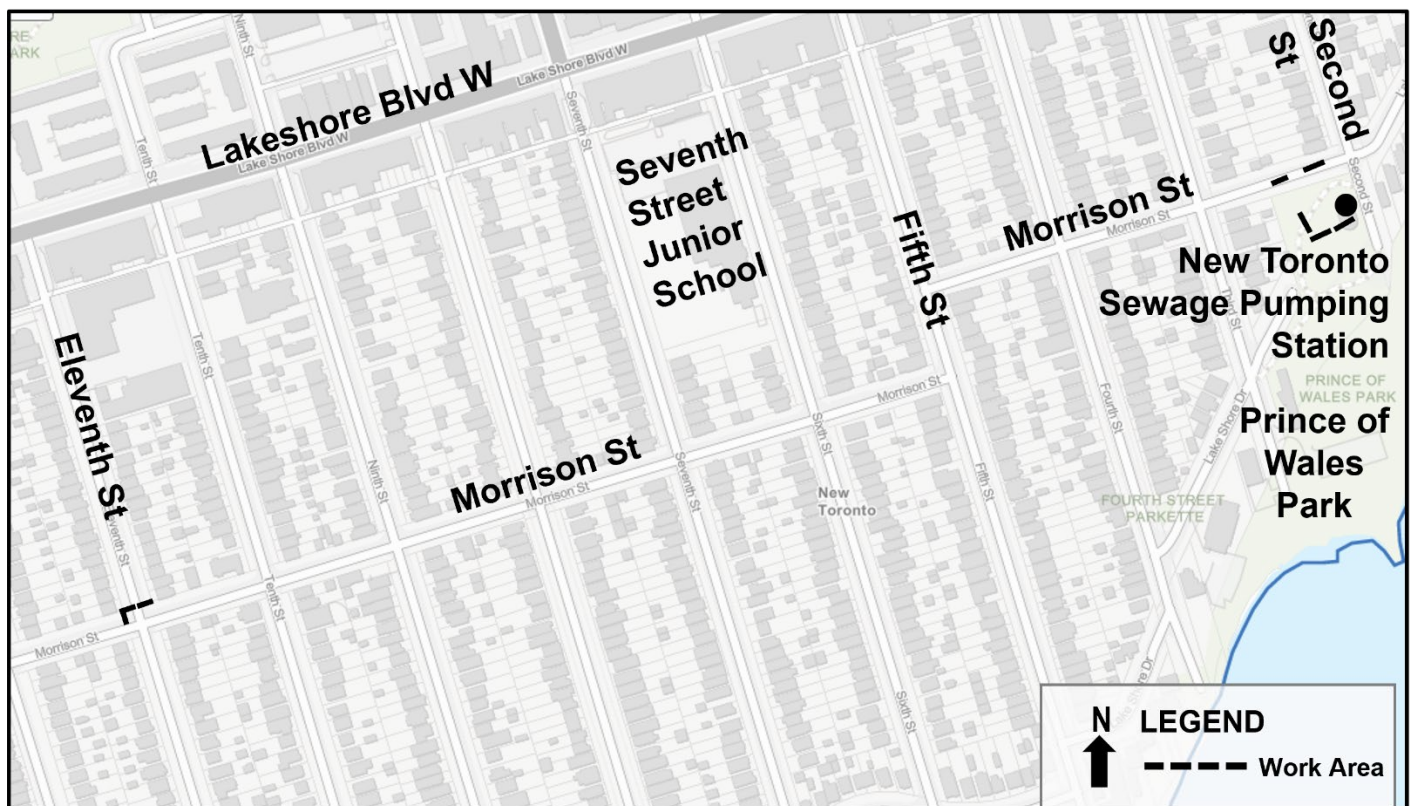
Sanitary forcemain replacement on your street

In February 2024, the City of Toronto distributed a Project Update Notice for a sanitary forcemain (a pressurized sewer pipe that transports wastewater from a lower to higher elevation) replacement in your neighbourhood. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure, reducing the risk of forechain breaks and collapses.

The City has begun preliminary activities on **Morrison Street at Eleventh Street**, on **Morrison Street west of Second Street** and at the **New Toronto Sewage Pumping Station**. Please see a map of the work area below. Active construction at the site will begin in **May 2024**, earlier than the July start date last reported to you in the previous Project Update Notice. The work is expected to be completed by **November 2024**.

Restoration work, where required, is expected to be completed by spring 2025. Restoration work may be completed earlier, should scheduling and weather allow.
