

# Construction Notice Update

## Fairbank-Silverthorn Storm Trunk Sewer System Construction on Harvie Avenue, Kitchener Ave, Chudleigh Rd, Ennerdale Rd and Holmesdale Rd

**Contract: 21ECS-LU-01TT**

**Harvie Collector Construction End Date: Summer 2024**

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto has begun work on the construction of a new storm sewer system that will collect, store and move stormwater (rain and melted snow) from the Fairbank-Silverthorn area to Black Creek. This work is part of the City's Basement Flooding Protection Program to help reduce the risk of future basement flooding. Once complete, the new storm sewer system will help to reduce the impact of heavy rainfall and sewer back-ups for more than 4,600 homes in your area.

The construction at three shaft compounds, Harvie Ave/Chudleigh Rd, Chudleigh Rd/Ennerdale Rd, and Ennerdale Rd/ Holmesdale Rd were completed and the roads and sidewalks were temporarily restored in December 2023.

### **Update on Remaining Final Restoration Work ( Refer to Map on page 2):**

- Final asphalt restoration will be completed on Harvie Ave/Chudleigh Rd, Chudleigh Rd/Ennerdale Rd and Ennerdale Rd/ Holmesdale Rd in May 2024 and is weather dependant. Staged closures are expected over a period two days to complete these works.
  - Landscaping restoration will be completed in Summer 2024. Road or sidewalk closures will not be impacted during landscaping restoration.
- The construction compound located at the intersection of Harvie Ave/Kitchener Ave will be restored and reopened to the public by the end of Summer 2024.

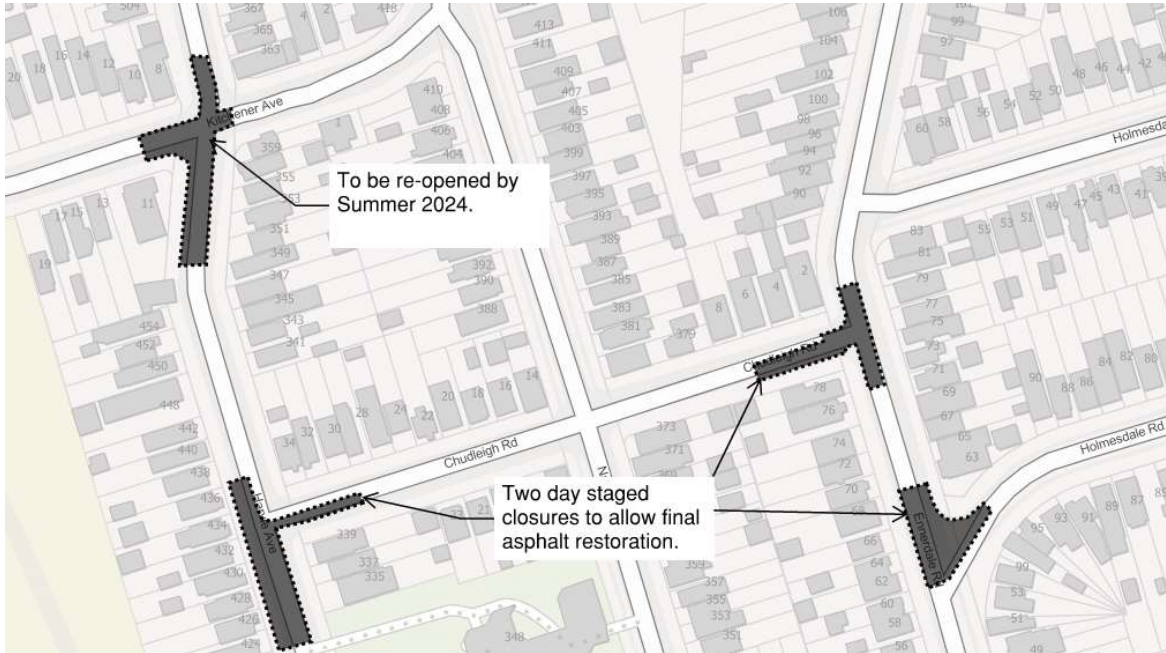
