



## Rehabilitation of Bridges and Elevated Roads Near Eastern Ave. and Adelaide St. East

**Contract: 24ECS-BE-09SB**  
**Anticipated Start Date: July 2024**  
**Anticipated End Date: Early 2027**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Eastern Avenue Bridge (ID264), the Richmond Street East over King Street East Bridge (ID246), Adelaide Street East over King Street East Bridge (ID266), and the Don Valley Parkway Ramp over the Don River (ID263). This work will ensure that the bridges meet today’s standards and remain safe into the future. The work also includes construction of a multi-use trail on the Eastern Avenue Bridge (ID264). The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Impacted properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will occur between the hours of 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday to Sunday, including holidays.</p> <p><b>Overnight Work:</b> Some tasks, including rehabilitation of the Don Valley Parkway Ramp over the Don River (ID263), will require overnight work. Timelines for overnight work will be communicated in advance. During these times, construction impacts and noise levels are expected to be similar to daytime construction activities.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>At least one lane on Eastern Avenue, Richmond Street East and Adelaide Street East will remain open in each direction at all times.</p> <p>The Don Valley Parkway Ramp will require a full closure for a few months to facilitate the completion of the work. Details regarding the dates and duration of the closure will be provided in advance.</p>

	<p>Streets below the bridges including St. Lawrence Street, Lower River Street, Bayview Avenue, as well as the Don Valley Parkway – will experience periodic road impacts throughout the project. These disruptions will not all occur at the same time. All impacted roads will continue to stay open to traffic.</p> <p>Detailed information about these impacts will be provided in an upcoming Construction Notice.</p>
	<p><b>Cyclists:</b> This work will impact cycling routes on Bayview Avenue and Lower River Street. Details of the impacts will be provided in advance of the work.</p>
	<p><b>Parks and Trails:</b> Sections of Underpass Park will be closed at various times throughout construction depending on the nature of the work. The work will be staged so that the Underpass Park will not be fully closed at any time.</p> <p><b>Art Installations:</b> The artwork in Underpass Park, including the mirrored art piece “<i>Mirage</i>”, will be removed and safely stored before construction begins. It will be reinstalled once construction has been completed.</p> <p><b>Farmers Market:</b> The construction work will also allow for the Underpass Park Farmers Market to continue to operate.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be localized road and sidewalk restrictions within the active construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Prior to construction activities, "No Parking" signs will be placed in the work zone. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted. If your parked vehicle is within the construction work zone where "no parking" signs are present, it will be re-located at your expense. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>Residents with on-street parking permits in the area impacted by construction will receive additional information regarding parking arrangements before work starts.</p>
	<p><b>Access to Your Property:</b> The City-hired contractor may need access to the interior and exterior of your property to complete a pre-construction condition survey. Affected properties will receive a letter about scheduling a time to complete the pre-construction condition survey. Although participation is voluntary, the pre-construction survey results may be useful to confirm claims for potential damage caused by City construction.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
