

Trethewey Drive Complete Street

Share your ideas for this project!

The City of Toronto is proposing to install a complete street road safety improvements and cycle track on Trethewey Drive, between Eglinton Avenue West and Jane Street. Complete streets enhance road safety and accessibility for all road users, including pedestrians, people cycling and driving by creating dedicated bikeways, improving intersections and improving bus stops.

The proposed bikeway would connect to the proposed bikeway on Eglinton Avenue West, the future Keelesdale Eglinton Crosstown LRT Station and public transit on Jane Street.

Trethewey Drive was identified in the 2022-2024 Near-term Implementation Program as an important route for people biking and is set for implementation in 2025 pending Council approval.
