
Intersection Closure Almore Avenue and Yeomans Road

Contract: 21ECS-LU-10FP Expected Start Date: Monday, April 15, 2024 Expected End Date: Monday, September 30, 2024

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. As the sanitary sewer construction work on Almore Avenue continues to progress, the road will be closed at the intersection of Almore Avenue and Yeomans Road. This temporary road closure will occur on April 15, 2024, until September 30, 2024.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.	
8	Traffic Management : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.	
	• Traffic on Almore Avenue during the road closure: Access to Almore Avenue and Harlock Boulevard from Bathurst Street will not be permitted during the road closure. Road users should detour from York Downs Drive or Danby Avenue.	
	 Traffic on Yeomans Road during the road closure: Access to both Yeomans Road and Danby Avenue from York Downs Drive will not be permitted during the road closure. Road users should detour from Bathurst Street or Harlock Boulevard. 	
方	Pedestrians: Temporary pedestrian access will be maintained on the north side of Almore Avenue and around the work area.	
Ŀ	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
