

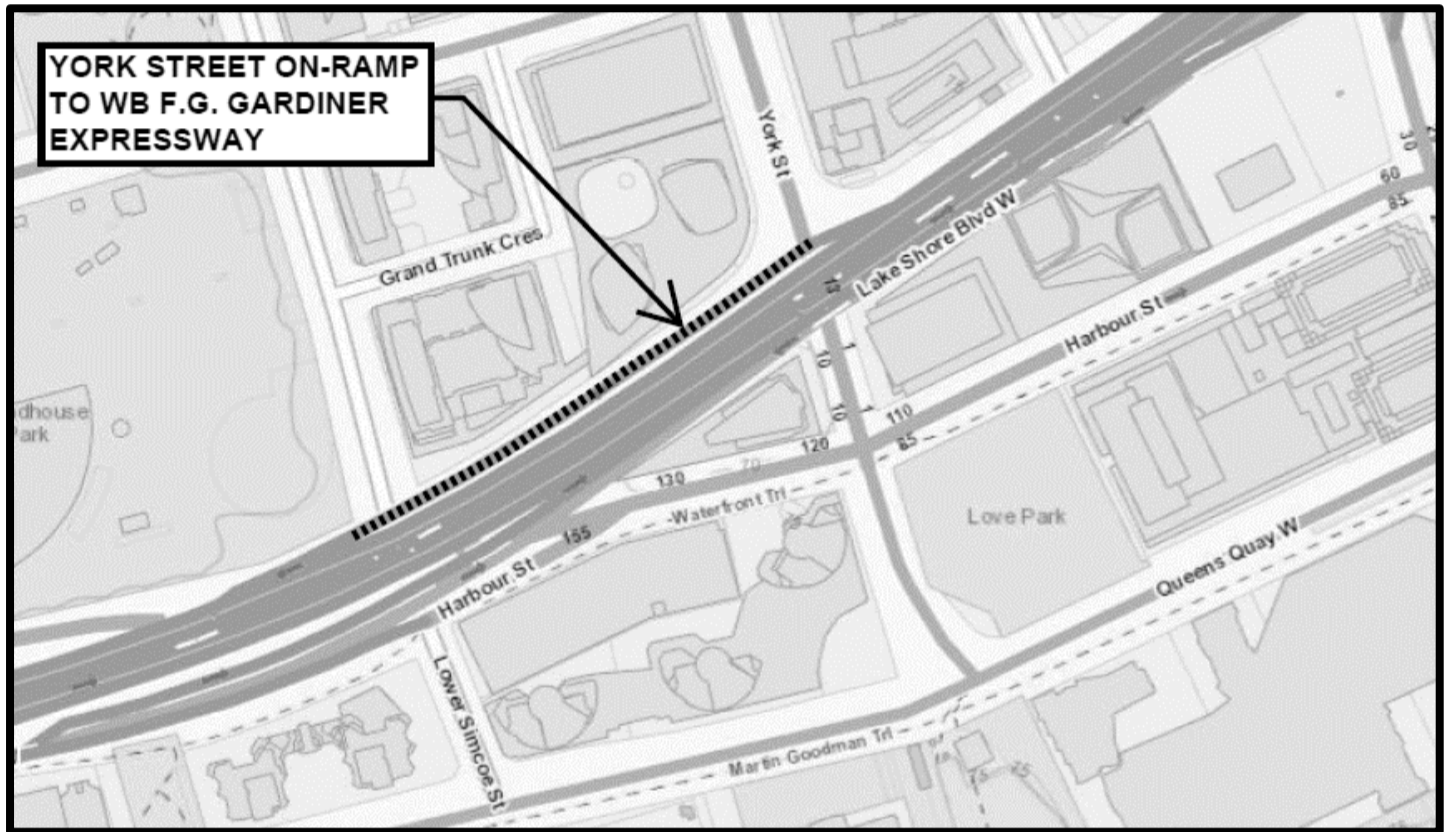

Rehabilitation of York Street On Ramp to Westbound F.G. Gardiner Expressway

Contract: 24ECS-BE-20SB
Anticipated Start Date: June 2024
Anticipated End Date: Early 2025

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the York Street On Ramp to Westbound F.G. Gardiner Expressway. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Impacted properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will occur between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, excluding holidays.</p> <p>Overnight Work: Some tasks will require overnight work. Timelines for overnight work will be communicated in advance. During these times, construction impacts and noise levels are expected to be similar to daytime construction activities.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Detailed information about these impacts will be provided in an upcoming Construction Notice.</p> <p>During the construction, the majority of construction activities will be completed with both lanes open, using narrowed lanes to accommodate traffic. While the ramp will stay open for the majority of the construction period, the work will require one full weekend closure and several overnight closures. Details regarding the dates and durations of ramp closures will be provided in advance.</p>

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be localized road and sidewalk restrictions within the active construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
