TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OLD MILL DRIVE AND CATHERINE AVENUE

The work to replace the storm sewer on Old Mill Drive and Catherine Avenue has been completed. The Contractor will be milling and paving on Old Mill Drive and Catherine Avenue causing driveways to be restricted periodically for short durations. Due to the nature of this work, Old Mill Drive will be closed between Catherine Avenue and Bloor Street.

Catherine Avenue will be closed from Old Mill Drive to the east limit of the Old Mill Bridge from **7 a.m.** on Monday, April 29, 2024 to 7 p.m. on Friday, May 3, 2024.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

Work crews will:

• Mill and pave Old Mill Drive between Catherine Avenue and Bloor Street, and Catherine Avenue between Old Mill Drive and the east limit of Old Mill Bridge.
