

The City of Toronto has completed modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the restoration work to reinstall the three pre-existing speed humps on Old Mill Drive, the road will be closed between street numbers 19 to 52 Old Mill Drive, effective 7 a.m. on Wednesday, May 15, 2024, to 7 p.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2024 as depicted in the map below.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

Work crews will:

- Grind asphalt to create footprint for speed humps in the three pre-existing locations
- Build full road width asphalt speed humps
- Line painting to follow after asphalt hump settlement

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- Road closure and driveway access impacts due to the restoration of speed humps.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Old Mill Drive will be closed to traffic.

- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained as open.
- Driveway obstruction notices will be delivered to homes between street numbers 19 and 52 Old Mill Drive.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
