F. G. Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation Project between Dufferin Street and Strachan Avenue



The City of Toronto is rehabilitating the Gardiner Expressway between Dufferin Street and Strachan Avenue. This project is the second of six projects that make up the Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation Plan (from Highway 427 to the Don Valley Parkway).

DEMOLITION AT EXHIBITION GO BEGINS

As construction on the Gardiner Expressway progresses eastward, demolition work over the Exhibition GO Station is expected to begin as early as 11:00 p.m. on Friday, May 31. This work will continue for approximately two weeks, followed by approximately one week of overnight work over the TTC Loop. This planned overnight schedule is necessary to ensure safety and avoid disrupting transit operations.

The demolition will involve saw cutting and hydraulic hammers. While the work will be noisy, it is expected to be similar in volume to daytime activities. Noise monitoring is in place to ensure compliance with contractual stipulations, with measures in place to address noise exceedances.
