Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Lawrence Avenue West from Little Avenue to Pine Street


Contract: 23ECS-LU-04SU Start Date: April 16, 2024 End Date: December 31, 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Lawrence Avenue West is progressing well.

To safely facilitate water service connections and minimize impact to daytime traffic and water service disruptions, nighttime construction work has been scheduled at the Lawrence Avenue West and Pine Street intersection on Monday, June 17 at 7:00 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Tuesday, June 18 at 7:00 a.m.

In the event of inclement weather or other delays, the work will be deferred or extended to subsequent nights.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, fencing, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

 One lane closure is expected during this work at the intersection of Lawrence Avenue West and Pine Street Intersection.

Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be always maintained.

Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be always kept open.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call **416-808-2222** for its location.
