

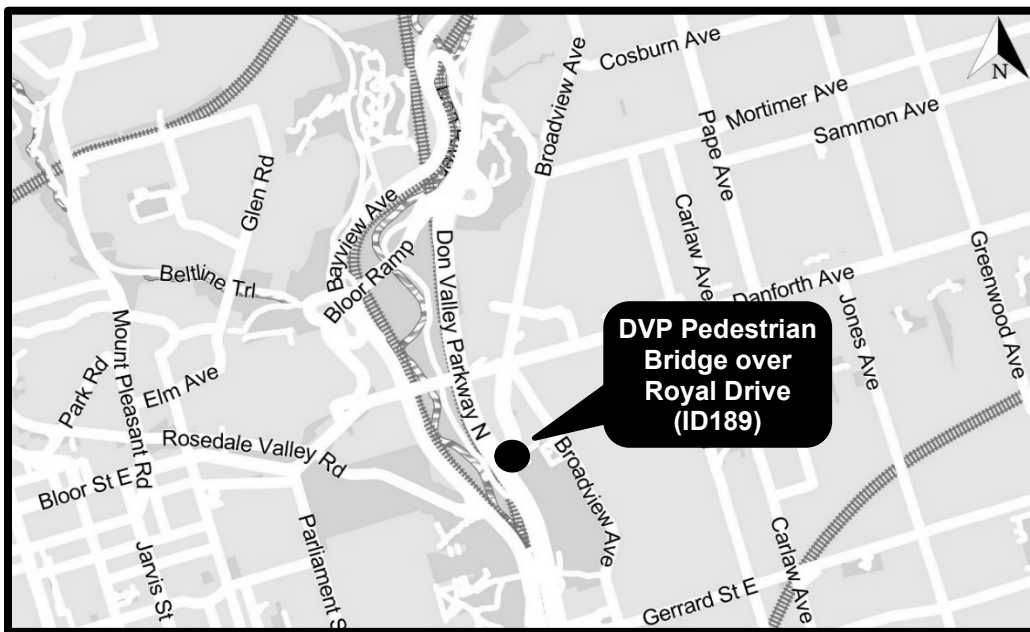

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Don Valley Parkway Pedestrian Bridge over Royal Drive. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remain safe into the future. **The bridge will be closed to pedestrians for the duration of construction.** Further details will be provided in an upcoming Construction Notice. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
