



The proposed work is required to replace aging underground cables that were installed in the 1950s and are reaching their end of life and involves the installation of an underground tunnel at approximately 25 metres below grade in the bedrock within existing road allowances to house the replacement cables. Three associated shafts will be constructed to provide access to the tunnel for operation and maintenance of the cables. The proposed work also includes de-energizing, disconnecting and capping the existing 115-kilovolt cables that run along York Street and Queens Quay. The completion of this cable replacement project would mean that the existing shallow high voltage cables that currently run along the length of Queens Quay from York to Lower Sherbourne can be decommissioned and presumably removed in the future. Based on early discussions with Hydro One, the construction of the new transmission cables is currently expected to begin in 2026, with the existing plant along Queens Quay to be decommissioned in 3n 2027



The City of Toronto, Waterfront Toronto, and the Toronto Transit Commission are completing a Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP) in support of the Waterfront East LRT project, and we would like to consult with Hydro One because we believe that you may be interested in the transit project based on Schedule 2 of the regulation.

To provide a brief overview of the project, this work comprises a Light Rail Transit (LRT) line that would connect Union Station with Toronto's eastern waterfront, known as the Waterfront East LRT project. We are completing a Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP) for the project area from Union Station extending south underneath Bay Street and east on Queens Quay (see figure below). This TPAP is intended to replace the previously approved 2010 East Bayfront Transit Class EA, which has since expired. This project will bring much needed higher order transit service from Union Station to the eastern waterfront for current and future residents, visitors and workers.



We are currently in the pre-planning consultation phase of the TPAP and aim to issue our Notice of Commencement in Fall 2023. We have prepared a draft Environmental Project Report (EPR) for the project, and would like to request your review of this document pertaining to any areas of interest for your agency. We would be pleased to receive and discuss any comments you may have on the project or EPR. Please note that some detailed elements of the transit project—such as precise transit stop locations, future bus routes, target operating statistics, and intersection configurations—are

being advanced through ongoing coordination among the project Proponents and design teams, as identified in the EPR. These details will be confirmed and updated as necessary prior to the issuance of the Notice of Commencement. These are not anticipated to have a material impact on the project impacts, however any early TPAP reviewers will be informed of any changes from the current version and any resultant changes to the project impacts.

Please confirm if you are missing any files of interest (all appendix files are listed in the EPR Table of Contents), as some issues have been encountered with file sharing using SharePoint.
