

## Danforth Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation over Kingston Road

#### Contract: 24ECS-BE-17PM Start Date: August 2024 End Date: December 2024 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate Eastbound Danforth Avenue Bridge over Westbound Kingston Road. This work will ensure that the bridge and road meet today's standards and remain safe into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks, curbs requiring replacement, the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water, and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
