Overnight Water Service Connections on Woburn Avenue and Avenue Road

Contract: 24ECS-LU-01SU Start Date: February 2024 End Date: December 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Woburn Avenue is progressing. To safely facilitate the service connections and minimize impact to daytime traffic and service disruption, nighttime construction work has been scheduled for:


Street connection work on Woburn Avenue and Avenue Road will start on Sunday,
June 23 at 7:00 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Monday, June 24 at 5:00 a.m.

Residents should expect construction noise in the immediate work zone. In the event of inclement weather or other delays to the work, the work will be deferred or extended to subsequent nights.

We know this project has an impact to residents and businesses along Woburn Avenue. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences due to construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.



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Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

 Nightwork is currently scheduled for Sunday, June 23 at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Monday, June 24 at 5 a.m.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

 During the nightwork, traffic within the work zone may be reduced to one lane



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
