Intersection Improvements at Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP

Start Date: Late-Summer 2024 End Date: November 2024

The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the intersection at Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive. This project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

As part of the upcoming work, the City will be making changes to the design of the intersection to increase safety and connectivity for all road users. Changes include:

- Removing the right-turn channels to create shorter, more direct travel paths for people walking and people cycling.
- Widening sidewalks and increasing green space with trees, plantings and places to sit.



The [Vision Zero Road Safety Plan](#) calls for engineering improvements where they are most needed to protect vulnerable users of our transportation system – people walking, children, seniors and people cycling.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, please contact us at the information listed below.
	Traffic Management: Efforts will be made to manage traffic and closures in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets during this project.

OTHER PLANNED CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA

- The City of Toronto is preparing to install cycle tracks on Ferrand Drive, Rocherfort Drive and Deauville Lane, from Rocherfort Drive to St. Dennis Drive.
