Road Reconstruction on Knox Avenue from Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP

Start Date: Late-Summer 2024 End Date: November 2024


The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the road and replace the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Knox Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Lake Shore Boulevard East. The roadwork provides an opportunity to improve safety for all road users and create a connection between the existing multi-use trail on Lake Shore Boulevard East and the existing Knox Avenue contra-flow bike lane north of Eastern Avenue.

As part of the upcoming work, the City will be making improvements to increase safety and connectivity for all road users. The work includes:

- Road reconstruction on the west side of Knox Avenue to build new separated two-way cycle tracks connecting Eastern Avenue with the Lake Shore Boulevard multi-use trail.
- Widening the sidewalk on the west side of Knox Avenue, south of Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East.
- Road resurfacing on the east side of Knox Avenue.
- Modifications to the traffic signal at the intersection of Knox Avenue and Eastern Avenue.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.
