F. G. Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation Project between Dufferin Street and Strachan Avenue

Contract #: 22ECS-BE-01GE

The City of Toronto is rehabilitating the Gardiner Expressway between Dufferin Street and Strachan Avenue. This project is the second of six projects that make up the Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation Plan (from Highway 427 to the Don Valley Parkway).

DEMOLITION & RECONSTRUCTION WORK BEGINS

As the City continues to make progress in the rehabilitation of the Gardiner Expressway between Dufferin Street and Strachan Avenue, the next stage of the work - the demolition and reconstruction is scheduled to begin in early to mid-May. The work will take place in three main stages, ensuring a minimum of two lanes of traffic are open in each direction (with intermittent, additional lane reductions as required):


- Stage 1 (South Portion)
- Stage 2 (Centre Portion)
- Stage 3 (North Portion)

Work will include:

- Full demolition and rebuilding of the elevated road, including all asphalt and the concrete deck and girders, and installing 700 horizontal support beams (also known as concrete box girders).
- Rehabilitating the support system for the elevated road, including modifying 35 vertical piers (also known as bents).
- Installing new concrete barriers.
- Installing new lighting and traffic monitoring systems.

Noisy Work

While the City aims to reduce noise disruptions, expect significant noise from demolition activities. Noise monitoring is set up to ensure levels remain within the set thresholds.
