Emergency Bridge Closure Stott's Bridge on Twyn Rivers Drive over Rouge River

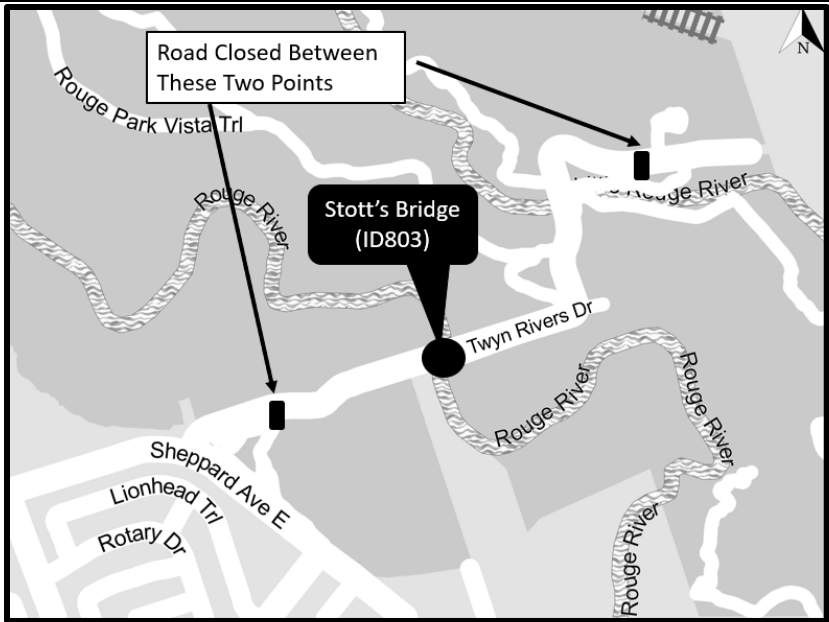
Emergency Closure Start Date: Friday, July 05, 2024

Due to safety concerns identified in a recent inspection, the City of Toronto has closed the Stott's Bridge, located on Twyn Rivers Drive over Rouge River, to all motorized and vehicular traffic. Twyn Rivers Drive will be closed from just east of the Parks Canada parking lot driveway at the west end to just west of Parks Canada day use area driveway at the east end. Access to both driveways will be maintained, and the bridge will remain open to pedestrians and cyclists.

Staff are currently determining next steps and updates to the community will be provided as more information becomes available.

We understand this kind of work can be disruptive. Thank you for your patience as we prioritize the safety of all Stott's Bridge users.
