### Blakemanor Boulevard Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek



This notice provides an update on the Blakemanor Boulevard culvert replacement over West Highland Creek.

Work on this project is currently behind schedule due to delay of the project at Chestermere Boulevard. In order to expedite the work, Blakemanor Boulevard will be fully closed at the construction site with no pedestrian access across the creek.

We know this project has an impact to all residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the impacts of this construction.

#### WORK STATUS TO DATE

To date, the City's contractor has completed:

- Pre-condition survey
- Cleaning and grubbing
- Erosion and sediment control fence

#### **REMAINING WORK**

- Shoring installation and excavation
- Installation of temporary creek flow bypass
- Installation of precast culvert, backfill with granular
- Removal of temporary creek flow bypass
- Reconstruction of roadway, sidewalk, curb and gutter
- Site restoration and planting

	<b>Work Hours</b> : Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
÷	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

	<ul> <li>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</li> <li>Blakemanor Boulevard will be closed at the culvert location, from 29 Blakemanor Boulevard to Chestermere Boulevard, for the duration of the project.</li> <li>No through traffic will be permitted, however driveways for local residential traffic will be maintained.</li> <li>Motorists are encouraged to follow posted detour signs for alternative road access.</li> <li>In order to expedite the construction, pedestrian access will be closed across the construction area on Blakemanor. Pedestrians are encouraged to use adjacent road to cross the creek.</li> </ul>	
Ŀ	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
