

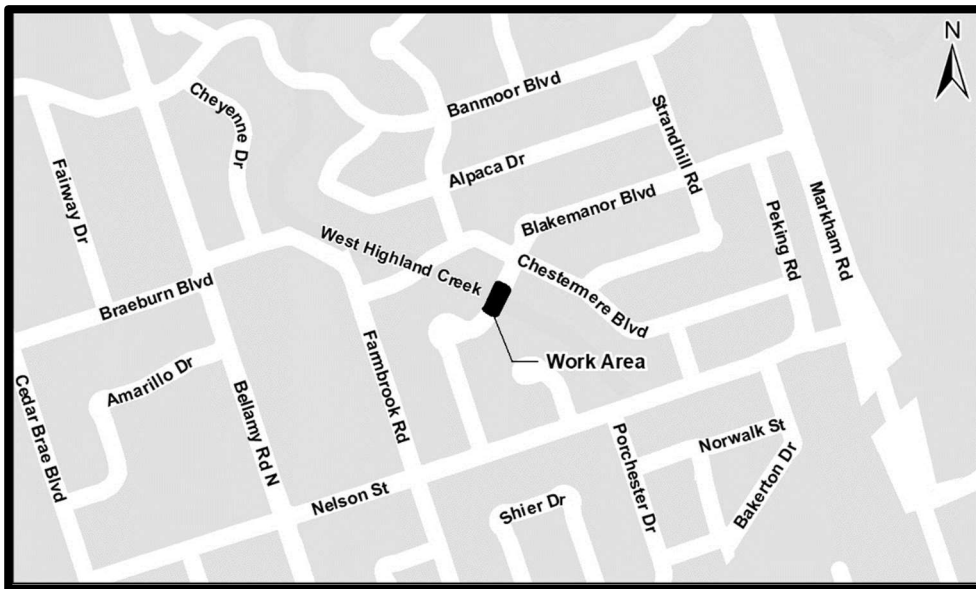

Blakemanor Boulevard Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-09BSE
Start Date: June 2024 End Date: October 2024

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the culvert at Blakemanor Boulevard over the West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today’s standards and remains safe into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City’s contractor will:

- Remove and replace the existing elliptical culvert with a new precast concrete culvert.
- Construct new concrete retaining walls.
- Construct a new riverstone channel bed and rock buttress.
- Replace steel beam guide rails.
- Replace the sidewalk, boulevard, full depth asphalt and lap joint within the proposed work area.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blakemanor Boulevard will be closed at the culvert location, between 29 Blakemanor Boulevard and Chestermere Boulevard, for the duration of the project. • No through traffic will be permitted, however driveways for local residential traffic will be maintained. • Motorists are encouraged to follow posted detour signs for alternative road access.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
