Intersection Improvements at Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP
Start Date: September, 2024 End Date: Winter 2024
**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will reconstruct the intersection of Deauville Lane and Grenoble Drive. Road reconstruction involves removing and replacing the asphalt surface and the granular base, as well as sections of curb and sidewalk.

As part of this project, the City will be making changes to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity for all road users. The improvements will help reduce crossing distances and slow vehicles turning right. Changes will include:

- Removing the right-turn channels to create shorter, more direct travel paths for pedestrians and people cycling
- Widening sidewalks and increasing green space with trees, plantings and places to sit.
- Relocation of streetlights affected by the reconfiguration of the intersection

This project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program to renew aging City roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that construction work does not interfere with these utilities
- Remove the road surface and road base materials
- Relocation of streetlights
- Re-align maintenance holes and stormwater catch basins
- Install a granular base and base asphalt
- Pave the road surface
- Install new trees and plantings
- Restore driveways and other areas impacted by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the Public Consultation contact listed below.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p>
	<p>Garbage and Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
