## Huntingwood Drive Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

**Contract: 23ECS-BE-07BSE**

**Start Date: September 2024**

**End Date: June 2025**

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the Culvert at Huntingwood Drive over the West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the existing culvert remains serviceable into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Replace the existing culvert at Huntingwood Drive over West Highland Creek
- Remove existing concrete retaining walls, and installation of precast concrete retaining walls
- Remove and replace gabion baskets to facilitate construction access
- Install chain-link fence above new retaining walls
- Roadway reconstruction and active transportation works including paving, waterproofing and boulevard works

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk opened at all times. A temporary signalized pedestrian crossing will be utilized to maintain pedestrian traffic during all stages. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the opened sidewalk during construction.</b></p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p><b>Traffic on Huntingwood Drive will be reduced to a one lane of traffic in each direction for the duration of construction. The existing TTC bus stop on the south side of Huntingwood Drive will be relocated to accommodate construction.</b></p>
	<p><b>Cyclists:</b> During construction the cycle track/bike lane will be temporarily closed through the work zone. Signs will be posted directing cyclists and drivers to share the lane, single file, through the work zone.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
	<p><b>TTC Impacts:</b> Some TTC stops along Huntingwood Drive may be impacted during the work. Signage will be erected to direct bus users to temporary bus stop locations. Visit <a href="http://ttc.ca">ttc.ca</a> for accurate schedule information.</p>
