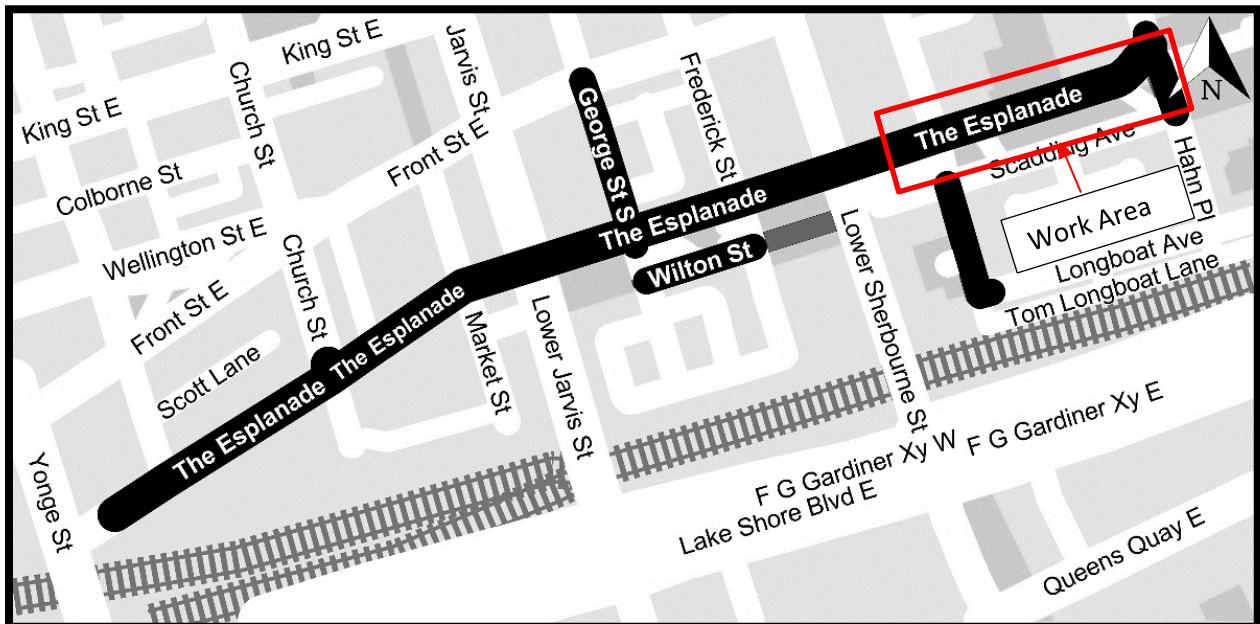
The City of Toronto’s work on The Esplanade, George Street South and other local roads is progressing well. This notice is to provide an update on the water service connection work on The Esplanade from Princess Street to Berkeley Street.

Water service replacement work is being conducted at night to minimize daytime water service disruptions.

The contractor will replace water service connections nightly from 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 11, until 7:00 a.m. Friday, August 16. The contractor is permitted overnight work to reduce the impact of no water service during the day.

When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this disruption. Thank you for your patience during this overnight work.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, fencing, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local traffic will be maintained during the duration of this work



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction.
