Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Lawrence Avenue West from Little Avenue to Pine Street

Contract: 23ECS-LU-04SU Start Date: April 16, 2024 End Date: December 31, 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.


The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Lawrence Avenue West is progressing well. This notice is to provide an update on the watermain replacements & service connections on Lawrence Avenue from Little Avenue to Pine Street.

Water service replacement work is being conducted at night to minimize daytime water service disruptions.

The contract will replace water service connections on Tuesday August 06 at 7:00 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Wednesday August 07 at 7:00 a.m. The contractor is permitted overnight work to reduce the impact of no water service during the day.

When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this disruption. Thank you for your patience during this overnight work.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, fencing, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.



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Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

• Local traffic will be maintained during the duration of this work



Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be always maintained.

Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be always kept open.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call **416-808-2222** for its location.
