Temporary lane closures on Superior Avenue

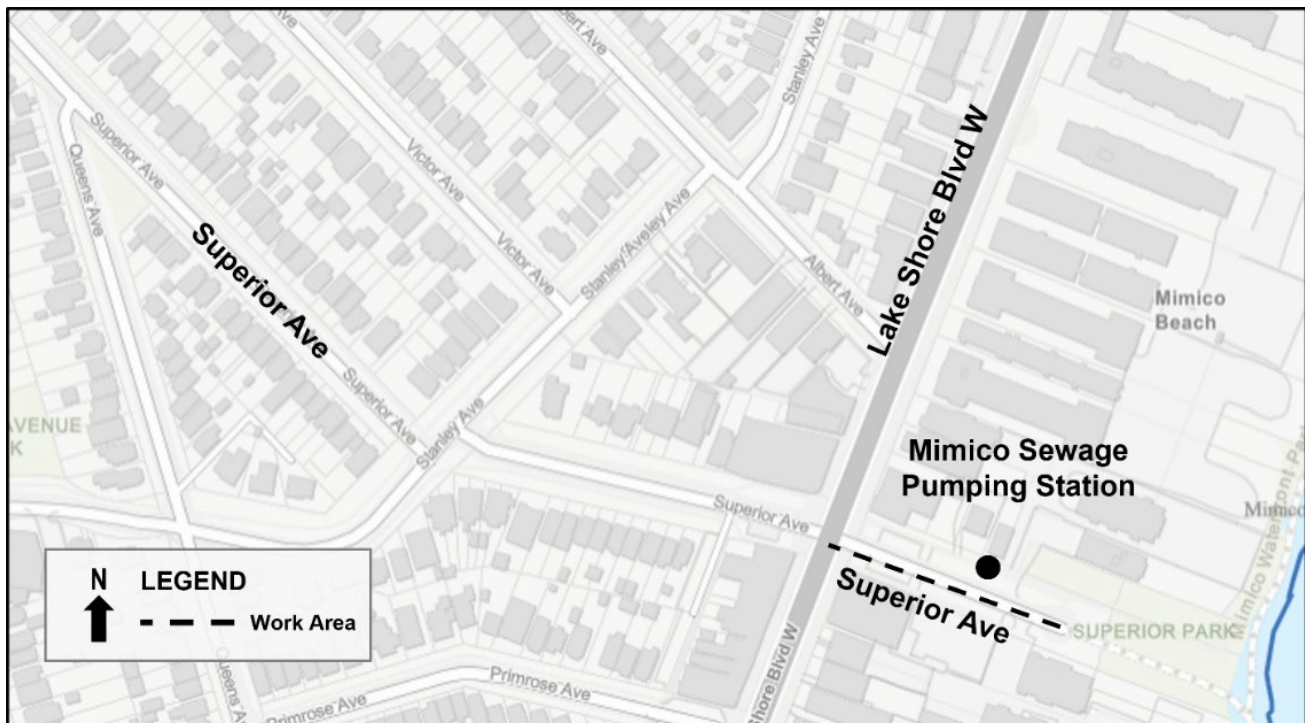

In February 2024, the City of Toronto distributed a Project Update Notice for a sanitary forcemain replacement to take place in your neighbourhood. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure, reducing the risk of forcemain breaks and collapses.

The City began preliminary activities on **Albert Avenue, southeast of Cavell Avenue, on Superior Avenue, east of Lakeshore Boulevard West** and at the **Mimico Sewage Pumping Station** in November 2023. Construction work was originally slated to conclude by November 2024. Due to site and technical constraints on **Superior Avenue, east of Lakeshore Boulevard West**, the construction timeline has been updated and is now expected to be completed by **December 2024**.

Due to the depth and nature of the sanitary forcemain construction work on Superior Avenue, there will be a lane closed from the **intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard West and Superior Avenue east to the end of Superior Avenue** with alternating traffic. All driveway access on Superior Avenue will be maintained. See details of detour options under Traffic Management on page 2 of this notice and please see a map of the work area below.

WORK DETAILS



For this project, the contractor will:

- Dig a trench in the road in stages to install the new sanitary forcemains.
- Install the new forcemains and, when work is complete, restore the roadway areas with temporary asphalt and restore soft surfaces such as grassed areas to their original condition.
- Work inside the Mimico Sewage Pumping Station.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and decorative objects before work starts.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.

	<p>Work hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required and in accordance with the City of Toronto's Noise Bylaw. You will be notified of any work hours changes.</p>
	<p>Construction noise: You may experience intermittent noise and vibration during construction (from vacuum trucks, power generators, air compressors, etc.). All work will comply with the City of Toronto's Noise Bylaw.</p>
	<p>Road and sidewalk access: To safely complete the work, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During this work a temporary sidewalk will be set up at the end of Superior Avenue to replace the temporarily closed sidewalk. This sidewalk provides access from 2 Superior Avenue to Superior Park.
	<p>Traffic management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on Superior Avenue. Driveway access on Superior Avenue will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Lane Closures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be a partial lane closure on the east lane of Superior Avenue east of Lake Shore Boulevard West during the work hours of Monday - Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. This is to ensure safe working conditions, and the lane will be open at weekends and from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on weekdays. • Following the lane closure on Superior Avenue, east of Lake Shore Boulevard West, there will be a continuous lane closure on the east lane of Superior Avenue. A flagman will be directing alternating traffic Monday - Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and cars yielding to oncoming traffic from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. • Following the continuous closure there will be a partial closure on the east lane of Superior Avenue east of Lake Shore Boulevard, during the work

	hours of Monday - Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. This is to ensure safe working conditions, and the lane will be open on weekends and from 5:30 p.m. to- 7:00 a.m.
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October). Permanent restoration of the curb and sidewalk will take place within 18 to 24 months.
	Accessible accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
