



## Notice of Completion of Environmental Project Report Eglinton East Light Rail Transit (EELRT)

City of Toronto and Toronto Transit Commission

This notice is to inform you about the completion of the Environmental Project Report for the EELRT.

## The Projec

The City of Toronto, together with the Toronto Transit Commission, has completed an Environmental Project Report in accordance with *Ontario Regulation 231/08 – Transit and Rail Project Assessment Process* for the Eglinton East Light Rail Transit (EELRT).

The Eglinton East Light Rail Transit (EELRT) project is a rapid transit line (future Line 7) proposed to span across eastern Scarborough that consists of:

- An LRT operating within the centre of the roadway on a dedicated guideway, separated from vehicle traffic
- A route extending 18.6 km from Kennedy Station to Malvern Town Centre via the University of Toronto Scarborough Campus (UTSC), with a connection to the future Line 2 terminus at Sheppard Avenue and McCowan Road
- 27 stops along the route including five interchanges with other major transit lines
- Extensive public realm improvements along the route informed by the City's Complete Streets Guidelines including protected bikeways, wider sidewalks, multi-use paths and greenery
- A maintenance and storage facility (MSF) at Conlins Road and Sheppard Avenue East for the

LRT vehicles, and an estimated 15 traction power substations (TPSS) along the route



The following roadway changes are being facilitated to support the EELRT:

- Realignment of Eglinton Avenue East at Kingston Road
- · Realignment and extension of Beath Street in the West Hill community
- Extension of Rodda Boulevard in the West Hill community
- Reduction from four to two vehicle travel lanes on Neilson Road between Malvern Town Centre and Sheppard Avenue

## The Process

The environmental impact of this transit project was assessed, and an Environmental Project Report prepared according to the transit project assessment process as prescribed in *Ontario Regulation 231/08, Transit and Rail Projects Project Assessment Process*. The Environmental Project Report for the Eglinton East Light Rail Transit (EELRT) is now available for a 30-day review period starting September 10, 2024, at the following locations:

There are circumstances where the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks has the authority to require further consideration of the transit project or impose conditions on it. These include if the Minister is of the opinion that:

- The transit project may have a negative impact on a matter of provincial importance that relates to the natural environment or has cultural heritage value or interest; or,
- The transit project may have a negative impact on a constitutionally protected Aboriginal or treaty right.

Before exercising the authority referred to above, the Minister is required to consider any written objections to the transit project that he or she may receive within 30 days after the Notice of Completion of the Environmental Project Report is first published.





If you have discussed your issues with the proponent and you object to the project, you can provide a written submission to the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks no later than October 10, 2024 to the address provided below. All submissions must clearly indicate that an objection is being submitted and describe any negative impacts to matters of provincial importance (natural/cultural environment) or Aboriginal rights.

ரொறன்ரோ நகரசபை, ரொறன்ரோப் போக்குவரத்து ஆணையத்துடன் இணைந்து Eglinton East LRTக்கான சுற்றுச்சூழல் திட்ட அறிக்கையை நிறைவு செய்துள்ளது. இந்த அறிக்கை, திட்டத்தின் சாத்தியமான தாக்கங்கள் மற்றும் பாதிப்புகளைக் குறைப்பதற்கு முன்வைக்கப்படும் நடவடிக்கைகள் குறித்துச் சுருக்கமாக விபரிக்கிறது. ஆர்வமுள்ள நபர்கள், அக்டோபர் 10, 2024க்கு முன்னராகக் கீழே பட்டியலிடப்பட்டுள்ள திட்டத் தொடர்புக்கு, அறிக்கையை மதிப்பாய்வு செய்து கருத்துக்களைத் தெரிவிக்க ஊக்குவிக்கப்படுகின்றனர். சுற்றுச்சூழல் பாதுகாப்புமற்றும் பூங்காக்களுக்குப் பொறுப்பான அமைச்சருக்குப் இந்தப் போக்குவரத்துத் திட்டத்தை மேலும் பரிசீலிக்க அல்லது நிபந்தனைகளை விதிப்பதற்கு அதிகாம் உள்ள சூழ்நிலைகள் காணப்படுகின்றன. திட்டக் குழுவுடன் உங்கள் பிரச்சினைகளைப் பற்றி நீங்கள் ஆலோசித்துத், திட்டத்தில் அடையாளம் காணப்படும் தாக்கத்தை நீங்கள் ஆட்சேபித்தால், அக்டோபர் 10, 2024க்குப் பிந்தாமல், சுற்றுச்சூழல் பாதுகாப்பு மற்றும் பாதுகாக்கப்பட்ட பூங்காக்களுக்குப் பொறுப்பான அமைச்சருக்கு எழுத்துபூர்வமான சமர்ப்பிப்பைக் கீழே கொடுக்கப்பட்டுள்ள முகவரிக்கு வழங்கலாம். அனைத்துச் சமர்ப்பிப்புகளும் ஒரு ஆட்சேபைனை சமர்ப்பிக்கப்படுவதைத் தெளிவாகக் குறிக்க வேண்டும் அத்துடன் இயற்கைச் சூழல், கலாச்சாரப் பாரம்பரிய மதிப்பு அல்லது பழங்குடியினரின் உரிமைகள் தொடர்பான மாகாண முக்கியத்துவம் வாய்ந்த விடயங்கள் மீதான எந்தவொரு எதிர்மறையான தாக்கங்களைக் குறித்தும் விபரிக்க வேண்டும்.

ટોરોન્ટો સિટીએ ટોરોન્ટો ટ્રાન્ઝિટ કિમશન સાથે મળીને એગ્લિન્ટન પૂર્વ LRT માટે એન્વાયર્મેન્ટલ પ્રોજેક્ટ રિપોર્ટ પૂર્ણ કર્યો છે. રિપોર્ટમાં પ્રોજેક્ટની સંભવિત અસરોનો અને અસરોને ધટાડવા માટેના પ્રસ્તાવિત પગલાંઓનો સારાંશ આપવામાં આવ્યો છે. રસ ધરાવતા વ્યક્તિઓને 10 ઓક્ટોબર, 2024 સુધીમાં રિપોર્ટની સમીક્ષા કરવા માટે અને નીચે સૂચિબલ્દ્ર પ્રોજેક્ટના સંપર્ક સ્થાન પર તેના અંગે ટિપ્પણીઓ આપવા માટે પ્રોત્સાહિત કરવામાં આવે છે. એવા સંજોગો હોય છે કે જ્યાં પર્યાવરણ, સંરક્ષણ અને પાર્ક મંત્રી પાસે ટ્રાન્ઝિટ પ્રોજેક્ટ પર વધુ વિચારવાની અથવા તેના પર શરતો લાદવાની સત્તા છે. જો તમે તમારી સમસ્યાઓની ચર્યા પ્રોજેક્ટ ટીમ સાથે કરી હોય અને તમને પ્રોજેક્ટની ઓળખ કરાયેલી અસર સામે વાંધો હોય તો તમે 10 ઓક્ટોબર, 2024 કરતાં મોડી નહીં એ રીતે પર્યાવરણ, સંરક્ષણ અને પાર્ક મંત્રીને નીચે આપેલા સરનામા પર લેખિત રજૂઆત કરી શકો છો. તમામ રજૂઆતો સ્પષ્ટપણે દર્શાવતી હોવી જોઈએ કે વાંધો રજૂ કરવામાં આવી રહ્યો છે અને કુદરતી પર્યાવરણ સાથે સંબંધિત હોય, સાંસ્કૃતિક વારસાનું મૂલ્ય અથવા મૂળનિવાસી હકો ધરાવતી પ્રાંતીય મહત્ત્વની બાબતો પર કોઈપણ નકારાત્મક અસરોનું વર્ણન કરતી હોય.
