## Overnight Paving at Sheppard Avenue East and Willowdale Avenue Intersection

**Contract: 23ECS-RD-11MR**

**Start Date: October 10, 2024 End Date: October 11, 2024**

The City of Toronto's road resurfacing work Sheppard Avenue East from Bonnington Place to Bayview Avenue is progressing well. This notice is to provide an update on the overnight paving operations.

From **Thursday, October 10 at 7 p.m. to Friday, October 11 at 5 a.m.** the contractor will grind existing pavement, perform road base repairs and base layer asphalt paving at the intersection of Sheppard Avenue East and Willowdale Avenue. This work will occur exclusively during nighttime hours as scheduled, subject to weather conditions. The contractor is permitted to work 24 hours a day until the work can be completed and the roadway open to traffic; however, a minimum of one lane in each direction will always be maintained.

When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume. Your patience and understanding are appreciated during this disruption. Thank you for your patience during this overnight work.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be always maintained.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be always kept open.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p>Traffic on Sheppard Avenue East will be reduced to one lane each direction.</p>



**Accessible Accommodation:** The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
