### TEMPORARY WALKWAY CLOSURE: Elie Wiesel Park


Contract: 21ECS-LU-04FP Expected Start Date: October 1, 2024 Expected End Date: December 2, 2024 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding.

Due to the nature of the storm sewer construction work, the walkway in Elie Wiesel Park will be tentatively closed between Clanton Park Road to Bathurst Street, starting on October 1, 2024 until December 2, 2024. This work in the park also involves installing a storm box culvert from the Clanton Park Road cul-de-sac to the Erica Avenue cul-de-sac.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.
