Upcoming Watermain, Sewer and Intersection Improvements for Topham Park

As part of the ongoing Basement Flooding Protection Program (BFPP) work in the O'Connor Drive area, the City of Toronto is preparing to begin the final phase of the project. The final phase involves modifying and upgrading storm and sanitary sewers on St. Clair Avenue East and various streets in the Topham Park neighbourhood. It will also include replacing the watermain and intersection safety improvements along Westview Boulevard. Additionally, a rain garden will be installed in the median of Valor Boulevard.

This is the third and final part of a larger, hydraulically connected BFPP project for the O'Connor Drive area. The three phases include the O'Connor Drive segment (currently underway, nearing completion), Glenwood Crescent (completed in 2021), and the final phase in the St. Clair Avenue East and Topham Park area. These upgrades are designed to work as an integrated system. The full flood protection benefits will only be realized once this final phase is complete.

Construction is expected to begin in spring 2025 and is anticipated to be completed in 2027.


