

This notice provides an update on the rehabilitation of the Allen Road Underpass at Lawrence Avenue West.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the completion date has been delayed to Spring 2025.

We understand that this project affects businesses along Lawrence Avenue West. We appreciate your patience during this inconvenience as we work to complete this City infrastructure project.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the Allen Road Underpass at Lawrence Avenue West:
- Reface concrete substructure
- Reconstruct curbs, sidewalks, parapet walls with new railings, median barrier, and expansion joints
- Remove and replace asphalt and waterproofing on the bridge deck and approaches
- Concrete patch repairs on deck top and soffit, pier columns and caps, and girders
- · Remove and replace all streetlighting and underpass lighting
- Reconfigure pedestrian crossings, signals, and turning lanes at the west side of the bridge

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

 You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday. Some night and weekend work will also occur.



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Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



During certain phases of construction, sidewalk and station entrance closures will be required and pedestrian traffic will be shifted to either side of the street. During all phases of construction, pedestrian and accessible access to the TTC Subway Station will be maintained. More information regarding TTC impacts is provided below.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

During construction:

- Two lanes of traffic in each direction and access to northbound Allen Road will be maintained on Lawrence Avenue West
- Bus parking lanes at the TTC Subway Station on Lawrence Avenue West will be removed
- The Lawrence Avenue West westbound on-ramp to southbound Allen Road will be closed. Southbound traffic will be detoured to Marlee Street.
- Allen Road will maintain two traffic lanes in each direction.



Construction will shift to the north side of Lawrence Avenue West, requiring a closure of the station's north entrance. During this stage, the station's main entrance will reopen. Boarding for **Westbound 352 Lawrence West and Southbound Line 1 Shuttle buses** will also be relocated during this phase of construction and this will be communicated in advance with signage in place to direct customers.

Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required in Spring 2025.
