Road Reconstruction on Knox Avenue from Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East

Contract: 23ECS-RD-10SP
Winter Shutdown Start Date: Mid-December, 2024
Winter Shutdown End Date: Spring 2025
**Timeline is subject to change.*

In October, the City of Toronto began road reconstruction on Knox Avenue from Eastern Avenue to Lake Shore Boulevard East.

In December, our contractor will prepare for the winter shutdown. During the winter shutdown, the road and sidewalks will be temporarily restored. All roadways and sidewalks will remain open and accessible to the public.

In spring 2025, the contractor will return to complete road reconstruction and cycle track improvements with the installation of the two-way cycle track on the west side of Knox Avenue.

A Construction Update Notice will be issued before work resumes in 2025.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:

- Replaced the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services.

REMAINING WORK

In spring 2025 the contractor will:

- Remove the road surface and road base materials
- Install a new concrete road base and new asphalt
- Install the two-way cycle track on the west side
- Upgrade traffic signals at Eastern Avenue
- Restore driveways and other areas impacted by construction
