Sanitary forcemain replacement on your street

In June 2024, the City of Toronto distributed a Construction Notice for a sanitary forcemain (a pressurized sewer pipe that transports wastewater from a lower to higher elevation) replacement in your neighbourhood. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure, reducing the risk of forcemain breaks and collapses.

In August 2024, the City began preliminary activities on **Island Road** starting from **Brownfield Gardens** and **continuing east to the end of Island Road**. In December 2024, the City finished construction activities on **Island Road** from **Brownfield Gardens** to **Rouge Hill Drive**.

Active construction on **Island Road** from **Rouge Hill Drive** to the **end of Island Road** and at the **Island Road Sewage Pumping Station**, is expected to be completed by **March 2025**. Please see a map of the remaining work area below.

Restoration work, where required, is expected to be completed during spring 2025. Restoration work may be completed earlier, should scheduling and weather allow.
