## **Extension to Temporary Road and Park Entrance Closure: Heath Street East from Bennington Heights Drive to 100 metres west of Lumley Avenue (Moore Park Ravine Entrance)**

**Expected Start Date: December 5, 2024**

**Extended End Date: December 19, 2024**


This project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding. This work also involves replacing the city-owned portion of substandard water services and sanitary sewer laterals.

Due to the nature of the construction work and to avoid safety concerns, **Heath Street East will be closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from Bennington Heights Drive to 100 metres west of Lumley Avenue (Moore Park Ravine entrance), effective 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 5, 2024, to 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 19, 2024. Construction from Heath Street East will extend into a portion of Lumley Avenue.**

- Residents on Heath Street East and Lumley Avenue will continue to have driveway and road access.
- Pedestrians will NOT have access to Heath Street East from Lumley Avenue.
- Access to Moore Park Ravine from Heath Street East will be **CLOSED**. Moore Park Ravine remains open and can be accessed from Brendan Road, Moore Avenue or Hudson Drive.

Please use the vehicular and pedestrian detour route provided in this notice with the proposed traffic management plan. We apologize for any inconvenience that this closure will cause, and we thank you for your continued patience as we complete the work.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, and traffic delays.
- The city will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> Pedestrian access to Heath Street East from Lumley Avenue and Bennington Heights Drive will be <b>restricted</b>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pedestrians coming from Bennington Heights Drive will be directed to Heath Street East toward Bayview Heights Drive.</li> <li>• Pedestrians on Lumley Avenue will have to detour to Evergreen Gardens, leading to Orchard Green.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
