

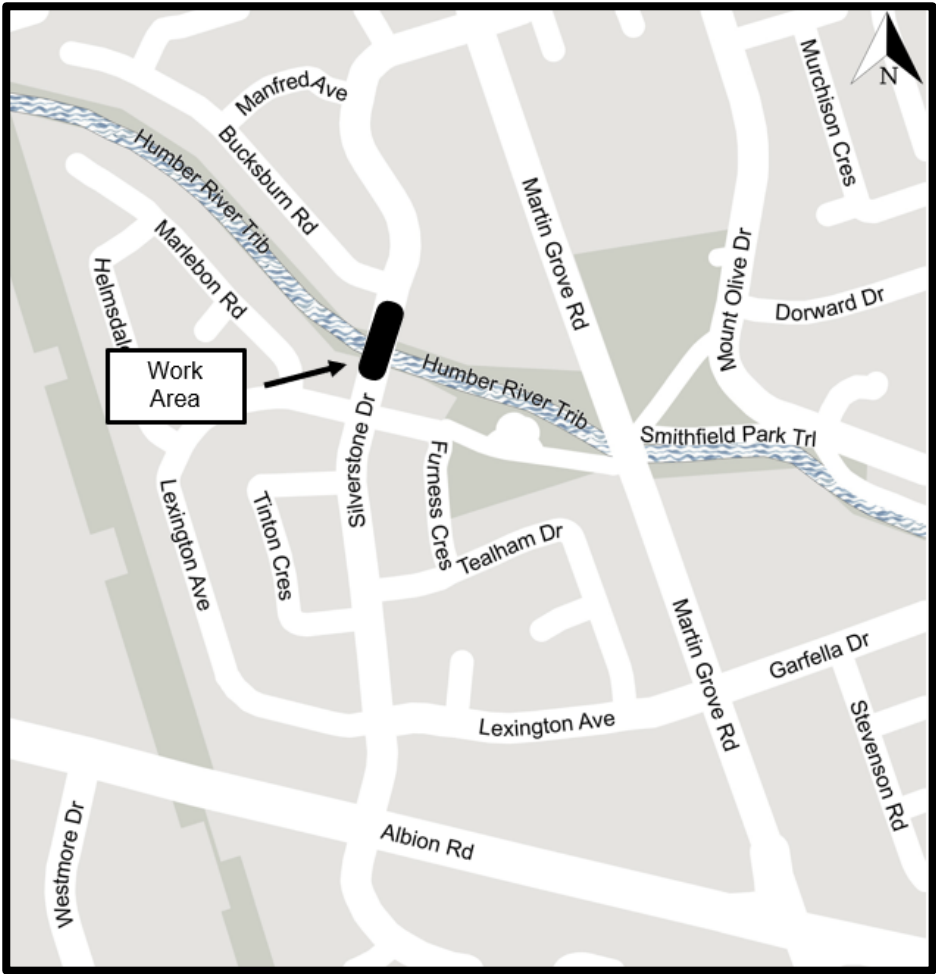

Silverstone Drive Culvert Replacement over Albion Creek

Contract: 24ECS-BE-01PM
Start Date: October 2024 End Date: September 2025

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the culvert at Silverstone Drive over Albion Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today’s standards and remains serviceable for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>One sidewalk will remain open at all times during construction. Pedestrians are advised to use the pedestrian crosswalk north of the structure or the all-way stop south of the structure to cross the road. For safety reasons, the school bus loading zone will be temporarily relocated away from the active construction zone.</p>

	Traffic Management: Two lanes of traffic in each direction on Silverstone Drive will be maintained for the duration of the project.
