

Grandravine Drive Culvert Replacement over Black Creek

Contract: 24ECS-BE-07PM Start Date: June 2025 End Date: May 2026 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the culvert at Grandravine Drive over Black Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today's standards and remains serviceable for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry longer notice, etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period. The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone.
	 Grandravine Drive will be closed at the culvert location for the duration of the project. No through traffic will be permitted.
