

ROAD RESURFACING AND BIKEWAY INSTALLATION	
Harbord Street	from Ossington Avenue to St. George Street
Hoskin Avenue	from St. George Street to Queen's Park Crescent

Construction work in this area is expected to shutdown for the holiday season on December 16, 2024 and it is tentatively expected to resume the week of January 20, 2025.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

To date the City's contractor has completed:

- Watermain replacement on Harbord Street.
- Watermain replacement on Huron Street from Sussex Avenue to Harbord Street.
- Temporary restoration.

REMAINING WORK

The City's contractor will:

- Complete remaining side street watermain branch connections.
- Complete sewer installation on Harbord Street from Huron Street to St. George Street.
- Replace any City-owned water service / sanitary sewer pipes that do not meet City standards from both the watermain and the sanitary sewer to the private property line.
- Resurface the road, including repairs to sidewalks, crosswalks and curbs.
- Install raised bike/bus platforms.
- Modify traffic signals at Ossington Avenue and St. George Street.
- Construct a physically protected bikeway.
- Construct bulb-outs and curb islands for planting and green infrastructure.
