### 2025 Local Leadership Grant

The Local Leadership Grant supports place-based, resident-led projects that focus on the five domains of the [Toronto Strong Neighbourhoods Strategy](#) across all neighbourhoods. The Local Leadership Grant will prioritize the leadership and participation of Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit and Metis), Black and other equity-deserving groups within Neighbourhood Improvement Areas, Emerging Neighbourhoods, and other communities of focus.

Applicants can apply for **\$5,000**

Funds are allocated with specific allotments for each TSNS Community Network.

**Project Activities funded through this grant must be implemented between July 1st, 2025 and December 31st, 2025.**

Group projects must offer community-based activities that demonstrate alignment with at least one of the five domains

- Economic Opportunities
- Healthy Lives
- Participation in Decision Making
- Social Development
- Physical Surroundings
