2025 Local Leadership Grant

The Local Leadership Grant supports place-based, resident-led projects that focus on the five domains of the <u>Toronto Strong Neighbourhoods Strategy</u> across all neighbourhoods. The Local Leadership Grant will prioritize the leadership and participation of Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit and Metis), , Black and other equity-deserving groups within Neighbourhood Improvement Areas, Emerging Neighbourhoods, and other communities of focus.

Applicants can apply for \$5,000

Funds are allocated with specific allotments for each TSNS Community Network.

Project Activities funded through this grant must be implemented between July 1st, 2025 and December 31st, 2025.

Group projects must offer community-based activities that demonstrate alignment with at least one of the five domains

- · Economic Opportunities
- · Healthy Lives
- · Participation in Decision Making
- · Social Development
- Physical Surroundings
