# Overnight Subsurface Utility Investigation on Danforth Avenue from Main Street to Victoria Park Avenue

Contract: 25ECS-LU-08SU
Start Date: Summer 2025 | End Date: Winter 2025

The City of Toronto plans to complete an overnight subsurface utility investigation, Quality Level A (SUE A), where a utility is exposed in a test pit using non-destructive methods like hydro vacuuming, on Danforth Avenue from Main Street to Victoria Park Avenue.

The contractor is permitted overnight work from Sunday, March 30, at 7:00 p.m. to Friday, April 4, at 6:00 a.m. to reduce the impact during the day.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Capital Works Program to renew our aging watermain and sewer infrastructure. Your patience and understanding are appreciated during this disruption. Thank you for your patience during this overnight work.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

 You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.	
	<b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.	
₩.	Traffic Management:	
<b>\$</b>	Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. The work may require temporary lane restrictions, however any necessary lane closures will alternate in each direction to ensure vehicle access is maintained during construction.	
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
